Credit-based assessment of PhD student activities at DSEBA

Legend:*= mandatory activity in the 1st year;**= mandatory activity in the 2nd year;= mandatory activity in the 3rd year***

I. Advanced higher education training activities

- * (sem.1, sem.2) Doctoral research courses (PPUA) = 30 credits
- teaching effort for under graduation students at EBAF = 10 credits for 6 hours (at most)
- * (sem.1, sem.2) Attendance of scientific seminars of the Doctoral School&others organizations (without presenting a paper) (on the chosen topic and discipline) = 1 credit/1 participation
- ** (sem. 3 or sem. 4) Paper presentation within scientific seminars of the Doctoral School = 4 credits (compulsory presentation in the 2nd year of study; the presentation will be based on a long written paper which will be kept on student’s file)
- ** or *** (sem. 3, sem. 4 or sem. 5, sem. 6) Presentation of a paper based on one of the reports in seminar of the specific department = 2 credits (a mandatory presentation, in the 2 or 3rd year)
- (sem. 6) Dissertation presentation in the specific department = 5 credits
- * and ** and *** (sem. 2, sem. 3, sem.4, sem.5) Carrying out 10 hours of specific activities per semester depending on the needs of the Doctoral School or Faculty (project writing, involvement in the activities of the academic journal, data base creation needed for the evaluation of the Doctoral School, conference of the Doctoral School, etc.) = 5 credits; certification of this ”internship” will be made by the coordinator of the activity, as the case maybe (director of the Doctoral School, journal editor, coordinator of research center, data base manager, etc)
- Participation (without a paper) in the scientific seminars of specific departments and scientific events of FEBA or other faculties of the Al. I. Cuza University (for cross-disciplinary topics) = 1 credit/1 participation
- Participation in the public defense of PhD dissertations in specific areas of study (highly recommended) = 0.5 credits/1 participation
- Research grant obtained through a competition (as Project Director) = 10 credits
- Participation in a research team in a project obtained through competition = 5 credits
- Participation in a team organizing a conference / scientific event = 3 credits

- Summer school, training workshop attendance, etc. (being awarded a diploma, certificate or another form of recognition) = 5 credits

II. Activities specific to mandatory doctoral program in accordance with the regulation/law (research reports)

- * Research report 1 presented to the supervising committee 1st year = 15 credits
- ** Research report 2 checking the progress presented to the supervising committee = 15 credits
- ** or beginning *** Research report 3 checking the progress presented to the supervising committee = 15 credits
- *** Preliminary presentation of the PhD Dissertation to the supervising committee (research report 4) = 5 credits
- *** Public defense of PhD Dissertation = 30 credits

III. Dissemination of research outcomes

- * Creation of a personal page on the website of the Doctoral School = 2 credits
- ** and *** Updating the personal page on the website of the Doctoral School = 1 credit
- * Working papers creation and posting on the website of the Doctoral School (maybe a part of a future end of the year project, literature review, etc.) = 2 credits
- Member in the Editorial Board of a scientific journal abstracted in international databases, BDI = 6 credits
- Member in the Editorial Board of an unabstracted scientific journal = 3 credits
- Publishing a paper in the Proceedings of an International Conference abroad = 10 credits
- Publishing a paper in the Proceedings of an International Conference in the country = 7 credits
- Publishing a paper in the Proceedings of a National Conference (including Republic of Moldova) = 4 credits
- ** and *** Paper presented at the Annual Conference of the Doctoral School FEAA = 4 credits
- Article in ISI-abstracted journal with impact factor and influence score higher than 0.25 = 30 credits as a single author or with the academic supervisor; 15 credits if there are other coauthors.

- Article in ISI-abstracted journal with impact factor and a positive influence score = 20 credits as a single author or co-author with the academic adviser; 10 credits if there are other coauthors.
- Article in ISI-abstracted journal with the calculated impact factor (recommended for the Excellent award) = 15 credits as a single author or co-author with the academic adviser; 9 credits if there are other coauthors.
- Article in ISI Proceedings already abstracted in databases recognized by CNCSIS (recommended for the Very Good and Excellent award) = 10 credits as a single author or co-author with the academic adviser; 5 credits if there are other coauthors.
- ** and *** Article in a journal indexed in 3 international databases BDI recognized by CNCSIS = 8 credits as a single author or co-author with the academic adviser; 4 credits if there are other coauthors.
- Article in journals abroad with ISSN, not abstracted in BDI = 5 credits
- Article in the country with ISSN, not abstracted = 3 credits
- Book (min 150 pages) published abroad by publishers from the list recognized by CNCSIS on the topic of the PhD dissertation = 30 credits
- Book (min 150 pages) published by publishers recognized in the country by CNCSIS = 15 credits
- Book (min 150 pages) published by a non-rated publisher in the country, including Republic of Moldova (with ISBN) = 5 credits
- Book chapter (min 20 pages) in a book published abroad by recognized publishers = 10 credits
- Book chapter (min 20 pages) in a book published by a publisher recognized in the country = 5 credits
- Book chapter (min 20 pages) in a book published by unrated publisher = 1 credit

Note:

- *Mandatory activities, for which a specific number of credits is given, have been created so as a PhD student during a doctoral program may obtain the minimum number of credits (180 of credits) and publications/activities for the grade “Good”.*
- *The activity will be submitted once for each category chosen by the student*
- *Credits may also be given to other activities specific for doctoral research training that have not been at the moment included in the list; the number of credits will be given based on the justified proposal of the PhD student with the approval of CSD.*
- *These credits will be given to all students being involved in such activities*
